The All India Council for Technical Education has communicated the approved intake in respect of M.E./ M.Tech / M.Arch courses conducted in various engineering colleges and in the Post Graduate departments of studies in the Universities in Karnataka for the academic year 2007-08.

2. In exercise of powers conferred under rule 9(1) of the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Master of Engineering (M.E.) and Master of Technology (M.Tech.) Courses Rules 2005, the Government of Karnataka hereby publishes the seat matrix in respect of M.E./ M.Tech/ M.Arch. courses conducted in engineering colleges and in the Post Graduate department of Universities in Karnataka for the academic year 2007-08 including the break-up of seats available to various categories in terms of rule 10 of Karnataka Selection of Candidates for admission to Master of Engineering (M.E) and Master of Technology (M.Tech) courses Rules, 2005. The Government seats are indicated in annexure to this notification. The CPAC, Belgaum will take action for selection of candidates to these seats as per the above said Rules.

3. This seat matrix is published subject to the following conditions.

- (1) The colleges shall abide by the norms and standards and general and specific condition stipulated by the AICTE while granting extension of approval and also the conditions imposed by the universities.
- (2) The admissions shall be made strictly in conformity with the regulations of the AICTE and the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for admission to Master of Engineering (M.E) and Master of Technology (M.Tech) courses, Rules 2005.
